<p>Campground Rules</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tent camping (only) is sold per/site, per/night for \$10. Payment will be collected at the site. • No pets are allowed at any camping area. • No open fires are permitted. Gas camping cook or backpacking stoves are permitted with protection such as a metal pan or placement on a camp table to avoid grass fires. • Camp sites are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. 	<p>Campground Rules</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tent camping (only) is sold per/site, per/night for \$10. If necessary, off-site parking is available west of the Oak Creek Hockey Rink. This parking area is accessed from Nancy Crawford Blvd adjacent to the Community Garden. • Shuttle van will run between the alley behind the Colorado Bar & Grill, the off-site parking area and the campground at 10:00am, 1pm, and 5pm on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. • An additional shuttle to the campground will be available at midnight on Saturday, the 5th. • The campground closes Tuesday, September 8th at noon. • For more details, check out the Labor Day & DitchFest Camper's Handbook 	<p>Other information</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is an adequate number of port-a-potties at the campground • No water is available at the campground.
