Main Street construction work is progressing right on schedule despite the weather. The second block is slated for asphalt milling on Tuesday, May 30th and repaving in the first section with the subsequent realignment of the detour onto Moffat Avenue planned for the first part of June. Things are on track for Labor Day Weekend street events to be on Main Street! Town Clean-Up Day has been scheduled for Saturday, June 17th and it will be staged at the County's Road & Bridge Shop at their County Road 27 location, and the "Clean Team" Town trash pick is happening then too.
