## Town Board Matters

The Town Board's next meeting will be held on October 12<sup>th</sup> beginning at 6 p.m. It is a full agenda with the presentation of the 2018 Budget, a meet and greets with Soroco Superintendent Rim Watson, and Colorado House of Representatives candidate Jill Ryan. The other House of Representative candidate, Dylan Roberts, is slated to stop by in November. The Board will also be considering an updated trash contract that will likely mean an increase in rates beginning in January, 2018. Todd Carr, Routt County Building Official, will be in attendance to present

and discuss an ordinance adopting the 2015 Building Codes.

Upcoming meetings include a public hearing on the 2018 Budget on November 9<sup>th</sup>, and the Budget's adoption slated for December 14<sup>th</sup>. Members of the community are welcome to Town Board meetings scheduled for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursdays of each month beginning at 6 p.m.
