ORDINANCE NO. 648

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND MODIFYING THE OAK CREEK MUNICIPAL CODE AT SECTION 2.22.030, ELECTION MAY BE CANCELLED - WHEN

WHEREAS, the Colorado State Legislature recently authorized the amendment of the Colorado Revised States (CRS), Title 31, specifically CRS § 31-10-507 Election may be cancelled – when; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Oak Creek Board of Trustees has identified that Section 2.22.030 of the Oak Creek Municipal Code should be amended to assure consistency with the said CRS § 31-10-507.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Oak Creek as follows:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS. The Oak Creek Municipal Code, Section 2.22.030, is hereby amended as follows (deletions are shown stuck through, additions are shown in bold).

Section 2.22.030 – Election may be cancelled – When.

If the only matter before the voters is the election of persons to office and if, at the close of business on the ~~nineteenth~~ **sixty-fourth** day before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent, the Clerk, if instructed by resolution of the Board of Trustees either before or after such date, shall cancel the election and by resolution declare the candidates elected. Upon such declaration, the candidates shall be deemed elected. Notice of such cancellation shall be published, if possible, in order to inform the electors of the Town, and notice of such cancellation shall be posted at each polling place and in not less than on other public place.


SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY, CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. All other ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after adoption and publication pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-16-105.


