### Town Board Matters

The Town Board approved the 2021 Town Budget at their December 10<sup>th</sup> meeting. In accordance with state law the budget is balanced. The budget includes funding for Public Works/Streets & Stormwater, Police, Municipal Court, Parks and Recreation which are funded by a variety of taxes, including local sales and property taxes. The budget also provides funding for four enterprise funds: water, sanitary sewer, electricity and trash. The enterprise fund revenues are primarily paid for by user fees. Tax rates will not increase in 2021 but user fees will increase for an average customer by approximately \$16.11 per month. The amount of the increase will depend on the customers actual use of water, electricity and trash.

The next Town Board meeting will be held virtually on January 12, 2021 starting at 6 p.m., and we urge you to attend from the comfort of your home via Zoom or Facebook. The public is asked to attend/participate via Zoom or Facebook Live to maintain the 10 person and social distancing rules. Masks are required if you do attend. **Twin Enviro** provides residential trash and recycling services for all single- and multi-family homes of up to five units, please have your trash and recycle wheel carts out for service by **7:00 A.M.** on your service day. Trash services are weekly on Tuesday's and every other Tuesday is the Recycling service. If you have any occasional excess trash / limbs / yard debris please make sure to put it beside your wheel cart for service. Please cut down limbs and branches (and cardboard) to no longer than 3ft in length and bundle with a string to aid your Twin Enviro driver with the reloading of your wheel cart. Any excess trash outside the wheel carts will be an extra charge, per wheel cart lift.
