Town Board Matters

UPDATES: At the April 22nd Town Board meeting the Board approved two revocable permits. These permits will allow the owners of Vivian Floral Creations & Gifts, 111 E. Main Street and Emerald's Closet, 107 Moffat Avenue, to display merchandise, place a small sign and provide places for people to sit outside of their shops on the public sidewalks, provided that the public can still easily use the sidewalks.

Following up on the Town's 2014 Recreation Master Plan the Town issued a request for proposals, and has accepted the proposal from **DHM Design**, a landscape architecture/river design firm for the first steps to collect data and develop materials for the restoration of Oak Creek applying green infrastructure concepts and opportunities that can be shared with residents to gather feedback and input for future design work. Funding for this consultant work is provided by the **Yampa River Fund**.

Summer Camp 2021

The Town of Oak Creek's Summer Camp filled up quickly after registration on Thursday, April 1st. We are excited for a fun summer of playing, learning, and growing with all of our campers.

The Town's Public Works staff will be conducting the annual **hydrant flushing the first week of May**. Please watch out for the staff as they conduct this annual maintenance work on the Town's water system. Consumer Confidence Reports were mailed to water utility customers in April; these annual reports describe the Town's drinking water conditions. Copies are available at Town Hall and on the Town's webpage.

Town grant for Sheriff Reservoir improvements. In March the Yampa-White-Green Basin Roundtable recommended to the CWCB the award of a \$73,750 grant to help the Town design needed improvements to the Town-owned 67-year old dam and to replace the outlet gate. This grant will provide approximately 25% of the funding needed for this design and repair work.

Town Clean-Up Day will be held on Saturday, June 12th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. or until the dumpsters are full, whichever happens first. This year the dumpsters will be located at the Town's Public Works facility located at 618 Lillian Lane. Town residents may dispose of two pick-up loads at \$5.00 per load. As the services are limited to Oak Creek residents, please bring a copy of your utility bill.
