Town Board Matters

The Town Board has approved a revocable permit that will allow a local vendor to set-up a retail garden center at the Main Street Park to sell seasonal planting and decorating materials. In exchange for this space the owner agrees to maintain the Park and install seven planter boxes to be filled with plants, adding to the recent improvements at this Park. A CDOT grant allowed the Town to purchase picnic tables, a bear resistant trash container and the bicycle repair station that are now installed at the Park. This year the Town will plant a live Christmas tree and a water bottle station in the Park. The Town Board is also pursuing development of the Town owned Tramway property, located west of the Town's Public Works shop, for housing development. The Town will conduct a housing needs assessment and financing plan to develop this property and help provide housing opportunities for local residents.
