### **Town Board Matters**

- 1. The Town Board held a public hearing and approved an application for a conditional use change at 224 Arthur Avenue, allowing use of the property for commerce and light industrial (warehousing). This is the site of the new Rod and Cue Club.
- 2. The Town Board held a public hearing and approved an application to allow construction of a single family residential dwelling unit at 307 S. Grandview Avenue. The lot is presently vacant.
- 3. The Town Board held a public hearing and approved an application to allow construction of an accessory residential dwelling unit at 314 Myers Street. The applicant was approved to construct the two story structure with a garage on the first level and living space above at the corner of Myers Street and Dodge Avenue.
- 4. The Town Board has reviewed local marijuana business license fees and reduced the fees recognizing that less staff and Town Attorney time is required to process license applications and renewals. The new fees collect the Town's cost to issue these licenses.
- 5. The Town Board approved pursuing an expansion of the Town's electric utility service area seeking to add properties owned by the Town and lying within the municipal boundaries, including the Tramway and Rollstone properties.
