Town Board Matters

The Town Board is accepting applications for a vacant Trustee position from registered electors in the Town who have resided in the Town for at least the last twelve consecutive months and are at least 18 years of age. The application deadline is 5:00 p.m., Monday, June 3, 2024. This is for a two year term ending in April 2026. Interviews will be held at a special Town Board meeting on June 6, 2024 and the Board intends to appoint the new Trustee by June 13, 2024.

The Board has begun searching for a new Police Chief to lead the Town's law enforcement services. It is anticipated this search will take approximately four to six months to successfully complete. During this period law enforcement services will be provided by Town officers with assistance of Sheriff Scherar and his officers.

Wild Fire Preperation

- Develop your fire evacuation plan and practice family fire drills. Ensure that all family members are aware of two or more escape routes, meeting points and other emergency details
- Contact your county Sherrif's office and ensure that your telephone numbers appear in the county's emergency notifications data base.
- Prepare a "Grab N Go" disaster supply kit that will last at least three days, containing your family's and pets' necessary items, such as cash, water, clothing, food, first aid and perscription medicines.
- Ensure an outdoor water supply is available. If it is safe to do so, make a hose and nozzle available for responding firefighters
- Complete a check list of fire sfety needs in your home.
 Examples include having an evacuation plan and maintaining smoke alarms and fire extinguishers
