January is Radon Action Month and Routt County Public Health would like to take this opportunity to encourage Routt County community members to test their homes for radon and remediate if needed. The only way to know your home's level is to test. We've included some additional information in this newsletter that may also be helpful.

Please visit Routt County Public Health at 135 6th Street, Steamboat Springs or Oak Creek Town Hall, 129 Nancy Crawford Blvd, Oak Creek to pick up a free test kit. Supplies are limited, so take action today.
