The Town is working with its consultant team, Norris Design, Ricker Cunningham and Baseline Engineering, to kick-off the efforts of updating the Town's Comprehensive Plan. Facets of the plan include land use, capital projects and water/sewer/electric infrastructure, parks and public facilities throughout Town. There are plans for several events or meetings that community members will be asked for their input, so look for mailings, postings and other information so you can be part of the discussions.

Town staff continues to work on funding the updates to our water and

sewer systems. We welcomed Adam Sommers, AquaWorks DBO, Inc. and Ben Beall, Zenobia Consultants, as our Town engineering team recently, and applications have been submitted to the State of Colorado, Department of Local Affairs, to help us fund this needed work.

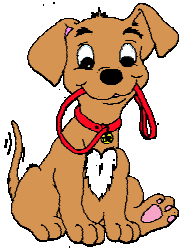
