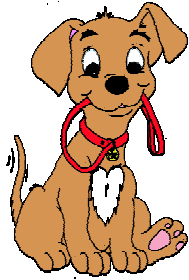

Notice of public meetings on proposed Yampa Valley Regional Transportation Authority



Local governments and community partners in the Yampa Valley are considering the formation of a Regional Transportation Authority to enhance and expand transit and transportation services for our residents, businesses and visitors.



We are inviting community members to learn more and provide feedback on this proposal.



Routt County; cities of Steamboat Springs and Craig; and the towns of Hayden, Oak Creek and Yampa will hold two public hearings as part of regularly scheduled meetings on the following dates and times. The public hearings will provide details about the proposed RTA and a draft intergovernmental agreement that is being considered by the six local governments for the creation of the Yampa Valley Transportation Authority under the state's Regional Transportation Authority law.
