The Town's work with the South Routt Recreation Association (SRRA) Trails Committee, Russ & Clay Garrity and others to facilitate the acquisition and preservation of 140 acres for public access trails adjacent to Town is nearing the finish line. The State of Colorado and Gates Family Foundation have made

significant financial awards for the project that are matched by the Routt County Purchase of Development Rights funding. We hope to complete the \$425,000 acquisition in late September or early October. Need more information? Stop by Town Hall.
